The splashback had to be lowered through the sink area to achieve this, and further alterations were needed for a new bifold window. Other structural work required in this renovation involved the laundry, which had to be removed, and the doorway to the garden needed to be centred. This

allowed for a better kitchen design, with the bench and storage space now located on either side of the doorway. Storage certainly is king in this room. The Shaker-style cabinetry not only looks good, but contains all the modern technology you could want in a kitchen today to ensure everyday family living is made easy.
